Arthur & Sons (Bridgehampton)

Off the turnpike in Bridgehampton is Arthur & Sons, the Hamptons outpost of the buzzy West Village Italian eatery. They'll serve old-school comfort food—like Caesar salads, fried calamari, spicy *rigatoni alla vodka*, and chicken parmesan—while a soundtrack of '90s hip-hop plays in the background.
